

REBATE PROGRAM

The rebate program will allow for those that can demonstrate a hardship, payment of half of the cost to make the repairs up to \$1500. The Council has set aside \$25,000 for phase 1, it will be awarded on a first come first serve basis as homeowners qualify. The following guidelines will be utilized to qualify for the sidewalk rebate program.

1. The owner of the property must reside at the property.
2. The owner of the property must apply and qualify for the rebate within 60 days of the mailing of the Notice to Repair Sidewalks
3. For those that decide to participate in the City’s cost sharing program, the rebate can be used towards the “up-front” one-half of the total cost of the project payment.
4. Income will be determined by the adjusted gross income on applicant’s current income tax form which must be submitted with the rebate application.
5. The number in a household is determined by adding the head of household, spouse, dependents under 18, disabled, and full-time students.
6. The amount of the rebate will be determined as follows up to \$1500:
