City Council Meeting

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FOR MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27TH, 2023 AT 5:30 P.M.

I. Mayor Parker opened the council meeting at 5:30 p.m. and called Roll. Council members present were Brian Dorsett, Tom Flanery, Shane Gliem, Stan Landon, and Curtis Thornberry.
