REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FOR MONDAY, MARCH 14TH, 2022 AT 5:30 P.M.

- I. Mayor Pro-tem Thornberry opened the council meeting at 5:30 p.m. and called Roll. Council members present were Brian Dorsett, Tom Flanery, Shane Gliem, Stan Landon, and Curtis Thornberry. Mayor Patrick Parker was absent. Staff attending Joyce Calmer-Deputy City Clerk, Doug Long-Electrical Superintendent, and Lisa Grossman-City Administrator. - **II. Approval of Agenda** Dorsett made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Landon. Motion carried unanimously.

- C. A discussion was held regarding the Electric Utility Reliability Plan Statement that is now required by the Iowa Utility Board. Dorsett made a motion to approve, seconded by Landon. With the roll being called, the motion carried unanimously.
- D. An upgrade to the warning siren from Unplugged Wireless was considered. The additional equipment, with a cost of \$2,180.00, would enable the siren to be connected to the National Weather Service System. After a discussion, the Council took no action to purchase the additional equipment.
- E. An advertising request from Real Deals for the 2022 Guthrie County Tourism Book was considered. The Council took no action to participate for this fiscal year.

- B. Landon moved to approve the monthly financials, seconded by Flanery. With the roll being called, the motion carried unanimously.
