REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FOR MONDAY, MAY 28TH, 2024 AT 5:30 P.M.

I. Mayor Thornberry opened the council meeting at 5:30 p.m. and called Roll. Council members present were Roger Dorr, Brian Dorsett, and Blake Michelsen. Tom Flanery and Mark Sheeder were absent. Staff attending were Doug Long-Electrical Superintendent and Lisa Grossman-City Administrator. The meeting was accessible electronically thru GoToMeeting as allowed by Section 21.8 of the Iowa Code.

II. Approval of Agenda – Dorsett made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Dorr. Motion carried unanimously.

III. Public Forum

Jim Wendl of 2881 HWY 44 and Pat Moylan of 5252 Panorama Terrace, were present to ask the council to reconsider the current ordinance regarding use of UTV's on residential streets in Panora. They would like to see the language expanded to include all residential streets and not just a route through town. Mayor Thornberry, with the consensus of the council present, requested that this item be put on the next agenda for discussion.

Don Daniels of 119 NW 3rd Street would like the council to address concerns he feels exist at the property across the street from him. He noted non operable vehicles and materials that are a nuisance.

Dan Vanwinkle submitted a letter to the council addressing various concerns.

IV. Consent Items – Michelsen moved to approve the minutes of 05-13-24 Regular Meeting and a Class E Retail Alcohol License for Casey's Marketing Company for Casey's General Store #92, seconded by Dorr. Motion carried unanimously.

V. Council Business

A. Dorsett made a motion to open the public hearing regarding the proposed FY 2023-2024 Budget Amendment for the City of Panora, seconded by Michelsen. The motion carried unanimously. Mayor Thornberry asked Administrator Grossman if there were any comments submitted, there were none. Hearing no other comments, Mayor Thornberry asked for a motion to close the public hearing. Dorr made a motion to close the hearing, seconded by Michelsen. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Resolution 24-21, was then considered, approving the FY 2023-2024 Budget Amendment for the City of Panora. Michelsen made a motion to approve, seconded by Dorr. With the roll being called, the resolution carried unanimously.

D. Mayor Thornberry recognized Public Works Superintendent Tony Monthei for 36 years of service with the city.
