City Council Meeting

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES FOR MONDAY, JULY 11TH, 2022 AT 5:30 P.M.

I. Mayor Parker opened the council meeting at 5:30 p.m. and called Roll. Council members present were Brian Dorsett, Tom Flanery, Shane Gliem, Stan Landon, and Curtis Thornberry. Staff attending were Joyce Calmer-Deputy City Clerk, Doug Long-Electrical Superintendent, Tony Monthei-Public Works Director, Matt-Reising-Chief of Police, and Lisa Grossman-City Administrator. II. Approval of Agenda – Flanery made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Landon. Motion carried unanimously.

C. Resolution 22-37 was also considered, approving an application for the Historic Downtown Business Commercial District Façade Rebate program for 108 E Main Street in the amount of \$3,687.50. Landon made a motion to approved, seconded by Dorsett. With the roll being called, the resolution carried unanimously.

A. Thornberry moved to approve the bills payable, seconded by Landon. With the roll being called, the motion carried unanimously.

B. Thornberry moved to approve the monthly financials, seconded by Landon. With the roll being called, the motion carried unanimously.

VII. Information Items. Public Works Director Monthei provided a verbal report on various water projects. Chief Reising provided a report on an inoperative police vehicle. Administrator Grossman provided a verbal report to the Council.
